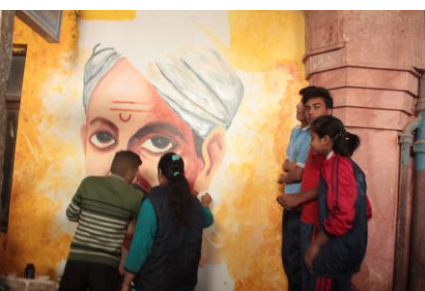
The Pioneer Champions

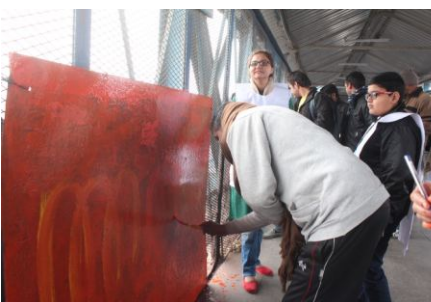
The Next Step
